

## **Lesson VIII**

### **Leadership Play**

**Goal:** To allow students to work together in a fun activity and demonstrate proactive leadership skills.

**Objective:** Students will be able to: Use leadership skills and qualities and identify what qualities to use with their followers.

**Materials:** pens, index cards

**Time:** 1 hour

**Leader's Note:** Explain to the class that you would like for them to create a play/skit. Divide the class into groups of three. Tell each group that you need a volunteer to be the leader.

Tell the groups that they are to create a play on leadership. Each skit will last 20 minutes. They must choose someone to write the script on index cards, assign the characters, and act out the play. The play should center around someone who does not have the best leadership qualities but learns to be a better leader. Include at least two bad leadership habits and ways the character learns to correct those habits to become better leaders. Try also to include some of the communication leadership skills discussed throughout this program

Listen to each skit. At the end of all three skits ask the following:

What was good about their leader?

What are some things their leader overcame to become a better leader?
