

Lesson IX

Leadership Prep

Goal: To teach students about planning and preparation.

Objective: Students will be able to create an idea web, pre-plan their speeches, identify why they are great leaders.

Time: 1 hour

Materials: pencils and paper.

Leader's Note: Tell the class that they will create their own President of the United States of America. Tell the students that they are preparing to present their President to the class. Give each student a large piece of art paper to draw on. The students should draw what they want their President to look like. Secondly, each student should write down what they think the family of the President should be. Do they have children? If so how many? The third component should be good leadership qualities the President possesses. The other component should be what bad leadership qualities the President might have and what the President does to correct those bad leadership qualities.

For the remainder of the class you and the students should come up with a large list of things the President is responsible for. The class should also be able to explain why each of these things are important. For example: The President is responsible for making sure people have jobs so that people are able to work and make a living. Once the list is large enough tell the class that tomorrow they will present to the class why their President is the best.
